During the last few weeks of term there will still be some exciting learning opportunities for our children. Please watch this space for our Easter events.

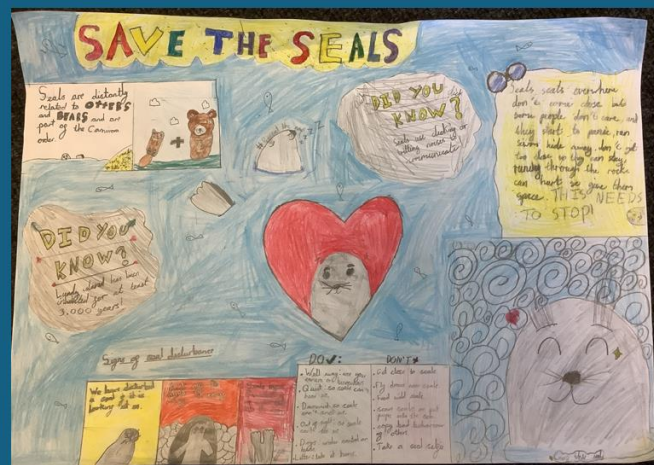
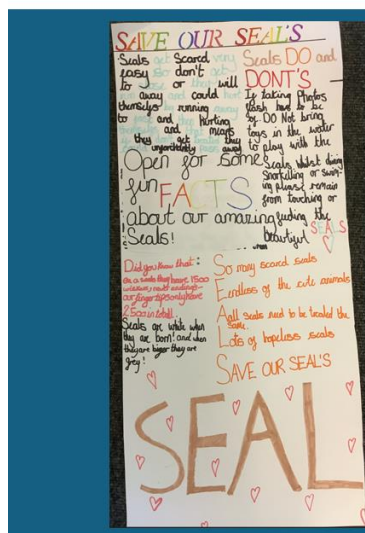

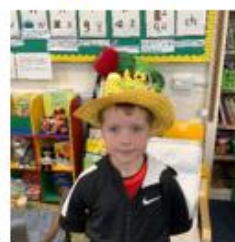
